

## **Summer Adventures Camp 2011**

**June 13 - August 26, 2011**

**Ages 20 months -7 years**

Pewaukee Lake Montessori is pleased to offer half or full-day summer camp experiences for children ages 20 months to 7 years. Camps run daily from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. half day, or until 3:30 p.m. full day, with before camp care starting at 7:00, and after camp care ending at 5:30. You may enroll for as many weeks as you are interested in but children ages 3 to 7 must attend for 4 or 5 days (Monday to Thursday or Monday to Friday).

Children ages 20 months to age 3 may attend 2, 3, 4 or 5 days. Children engage in a variety of indoor and outdoor activities each day. Each weekly session revolves around a particular theme and incorporates activities such as gardening, science experiments, cooking, music, arts and crafts and reading.

Themed activities will be only part of the camp experience, as campers will have plenty of time to play outdoors and indoors, engage in water play, build sand castles and make lots of new friends.

If you are planning to register your child for the academic preschool or toddler program in the fall, it is recommended that you sign up for a few of the summer camps. This will help your child transition better as they will already be familiar with some of the children, their teachers and the environment.
