

Summer Adventures Camp 2012-June 4 - August 31, 2012
Ages 20 months - 6 years

Pewaukee Lake Montessori is pleased to offer half or full-day summer camp experiences for children ages 20 months to 6 years. The children will be divided into 2 groups. Toddlers: ages 20 months -2.5 years and Preschool/Kindergarten: ages 2.5 – 6 years. Camps run daily from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. half day, or until 3:30 p.m. full day, with before camp care starting at 6:30, and after camp care ending at 5:30. Children engage in a variety of indoor and outdoor activities each day. Each two week session revolves around a particular theme and incorporates activities such as gardening, science experiments, cooking, music, arts and crafts, reading and sports. Themed activities will be only part of the camp experience, as campers will have plenty of time to play outdoors and indoors, engage in water play, build sand castles and make lots of new friends. If you are planning to register your child for the academic preschool or toddler program in the fall, it is recommended that you sign up for a few of the summer camps. This will help your child transition better as they will already be familiar with some of the children, their teachers and the environment.
